CASEY S. JONES AWARDS

These awards are presented to graduates from each baccalaureate degree program who have attained the highest cumulative grade point average in their programs while demonstrating the professional and civic values that exemplify the mission of Vaughn College. Minimum grade point average for this award is 3.50.

PRESIDENTIAL EXCELLENCE AWARD

This award honors and recognizes students who have represented the College and enhanced external relationships with college partners while maintaining a minimum Grade Point Average of 3.5.

FIORELLO LAGUARDIA AWARD

This award is presented to a graduate or graduates from the master of science degree program who have attained the highest cumulative grade point averages while demonstrating the professional and civic values that exemplify the mission of Vaughn College. Minimum grade point average for this award is 3.50.

ENGINEERING INNOVATION AWARD

This award is presented to a graduate who was an active participant in professional development or competition while at Vaughn College and who published or presented a paper on a new and innovative idea at a technical conference. This award seeks to honor students who have investigated innovative research projects in engineering.

ENGINEERING EXCELLENCE AWARDS

This award is presented to members of Vaughn's engineering-related clubs and teams for their activity in professional endeavors, community service, workshop development, and attending competitions.

BESSIE COLEMAN AWARD

This award is presented to an outstanding female graduate who has attained the highest cumulative grade point average while demonstrating the professional and civic values that exemplify the mission of Vaughn College. Minimum grade point average for this award is 3.50.

YEAGER AWARD

This award is presented to those students in the fast-track Air Traffic-Collegiate Training Initiative (AT-CTI) program who have attained outstanding academic achievement. It is named in honor of General Charles E. "Chuck" Yeager, who in 1947 became the first pilot to break the speed of sound.

MANAGEMENT EXCELLENCE AWARDS

This award is presented to students in the management program who are active in professional associations and have demonstrated competence in networking, facility tours, and the recruitment of guest speakers in the aviation field.

SERVICE AWARD

Certificates are presented to graduates, selected by the office of student affairs, for outstanding work in club activities and other special service to Vaughn College.

SENIOR ATHLETE AWARDS

These awards are given to Vaughn College senior student-athletes who have either completed their competitive eligibility, or will be graduating in 2020, and have contributed significantly to the success of their teams.

SCHOLAR-ATHLETE AWARD

Presented to the graduating student-athlete with the highest cumulative GPA (minimum of a 3.5 GPA) amongst all student-athletes while attending Vaughn College. Recipients must have played at least two years of varsity athletics.
