Financial Aid

When your eligibility has been determined, you will be notified by email. At that point, you will be able to view your award on [Vaughn College of Aeronautics and Technology: Student Login](#).

Be sure you have filed the [FAFSA](#), have pre-registered for classes, and do not have any “Holds” listed on your student portal under Academics – Holds [Vaughn College of Aeronautics and Technology Home](#). New York State residents must also file the [NYS Student Aid Payment Application](#).

The Enhanced Tuition Awards (ETA) <https://www.hesc.ny.gov/pay-for-college/financial-aid/types-of-financial-aid/nys-grants-scholarships-awards/enhanced-tuition-awards.html> recipients will receive a revised award notice when their eligibility has been determined. Enhanced Tuition Awards amounts are pending additional information from [New York State Higher Education Services Corporation](#) related to student aid changes enacted in the New York State Budget.

Common Questions

Why am I being charged a general fee?

In accordance with Vaughn College policy on Fees, the College charges general fees to all enrolled students to finance activities that are part of the enrollment.

Why did not receive a financial aid offer letter?

If you applied for financial aid but haven't received an award notification, or if you were awarded aid, you don't see it reflected on your bill, please check the following:

- Did you file the FAFSA for the correct aid year?
- Did you list Vaughn federal school code 002665 on your FAFSA application?
- Did the Office of Financial Aid send you an email or letter requesting information after you filed your FAFSA?

- If your FAFSA was rejected or selected for verification, did you submit new or corrected documentation?
- Did you secure your federal loans by completing the Entrance Counseling and Master Promissory Note (MPN)?
- For current students continuing their studies, have you registered or pre-registered for at least six credits.
- Are you matriculated in a degree program?
- Do you have a Vaughn.edu email address listed on Sonis?
- Does your email spam filter block emails from vaughn.edu addresses?
- Do you have the correct permanent address listed for yourself on Sonis?
- Did you receive a letter about your academic progress?
- For New York State residents:
 - Did you complete the Tuition Assistance Program (TAP)?
 - Did you list Vaughn state school code 2235 on your application?
 - Were you required to complete a state residency application?
